## What can Hospice Volunteers do?

- Companionship support for patients living at home or in a facility setting.
- Caregiver relief support to allow the caregiver an opportunity to get away from the home for a few hours to recharge.
- Bedside vigil volunteers provide presence for patients in their final days or hours.
- Provide support to our Veteran to Veteran program, which aims to pair Veteran Volunteers with Veteran patients.
- Provide support to grieving families by assisting with support groups and assisting with bereavement mailings.
- Assist staff at Kitty Askins Hospice Center and Crystal Coast Hospice House in various roles, including answering phones or delivering meals.
- Persons with musical and/or artistic abilities to provide healing modalities for patients in a facility or home setting.
- Volunteer at our annual Wings Camp, which helps children learn skills to deal with grief.
